Interests and Activities in Nursery

Roos

The children have been enjoying the mood light table, this interest will be extended to include investigating a rope light, introducing a variety of sensory play with a sensory board, bead run, textured materials, listening to a variety of different music and more. These activities will encourage the children to explore and experiment with a range of media and to move their whole bodies to sounds they enjoy.

Parent participation – Encourage your child to investigate different textures at home for example a sponge, shower pouf, scourer, carpet etc.

Piglets

The children are enjoying a variety of stories at the moment. This interest will be extended by introducing story sacks and props as well as creating displays around the children's favourite stories such as 'The Hungry Caterpillar.' We will also be looking at colours with a particular interest in red, green, blue and yellow. These activities will encourage the children to listen with interest to the noises adults make when they read stories and begin to take an interest in the different colours.

Parent participation – Please bring in different coloured objects from home for your child to show the other children in the room.

Tiggers

The children have been enjoying a variety of cooking activities over the last couple of weeks and we will be extending this interest by making fruit kebabs, cookies and pizza. These activities will encourage the children to talk about why things happen and how things work as well as to describe the texture of things.

Parent participation – Please involve your child with cooking and baking at home, encourage them to help you measure out the ingredients and teach them an awareness of temperatures as in the fridge is cold and the oven is hot.

The children are enjoying making different creations using gluing, cutting and sticking with different paper such as magazines and tracing paper. This interest will be extended to making 3D models using junk/recycled materials encouraging the children to build and secure their models using string and tape. **Parent participation –** Please bring in empty boxes and containers for the children to use to make 3D models with (no toilet rolls, boxes that held any nut products, raw meat etc, thank you).
