## **Interests and Activities in Nursery**

### Roos, Piglets, Tiggers and Christopher Robins

The children in all rooms are settling into nursery really well, whether they have returned to nursery after lockdown or are new to our setting. As the weather is changing the children are having an opportunity to explore and investigate a range of natural autumn materials such a conkers, leaves, sycamore seeds etc. We are encouraging the children to notice and talk about the different weather such as sunny, windy, rainy etc. All these activities encourage the children to select familiar objects by name, develop an understanding of changes over time and to build up a vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences.

**Parent participation** – Encourage your child to notice and talk about the changing weather. For example talk about how the wind feels in their hair, what clothes they need to wear and why, such as coats, hats etc. Encourage them to jump in puddles wearing wellington boots. Also while you are on a walk with you child please collect leaves, conkers, fir cones, seeds etc. and bring them into nursery for your child to share with the other children and staff, thank you.

## COVID:19 Update

We have had new Government Guidelines issued and are working through them at the moment. We will be updating our COVID:19 Operating procedures and Risk Assessments. We will share these with you once they have been updated.

Some of you may have heard in the news that a college staff member had tested positive. Although this is scary news it does not affect the nursery in any way as we have not come into contact with this staff member. The college has a comprehensive COVID:19 plan and are working hard to ensure the safety of all just as we are in the nursery. Just to make you aware to ensure that we keep all age groups of children apart as much as possible we take children to their rooms and bring the out from their rooms individually unless the children are based in the same room or are siblings. Unfortunately this may mean you have to wait a little longer at drop off and collection, thank you for your support and understanding in this area.

I am sure you are all aware of the increased workload that all of the staff are under, including Jasmin and myself, due to COVID:19 and unfortunately this is having an impact on the staffs ability to take as many observations of the

children and the time for Jasmin and myself to check and upload the observations. We are doing our best and I would like to ask for your patience and understanding in this matter.
