## **Interests and Activities in Nursery**

#### **Roos**

The children have been noticing shapes and numbers in their environment for example while playing with the shape sorters and in books. This interest will be extended by encouraging the children to join in with a variety of activities including shapes on the light table, shapes hidden in jelly, coloured rice with numerals, coloured shaving foam and number nursery rhymes. These activities encourage the children to explore and experiment with a range of media through sensory exploration using their whole body and to interact with others and explore new situations when supported by a familiar adult.

**Parent participation** – Continue to talk with your child about numbers and shapes in your home environment such as counting the steps when you walk upstairs and talking about shapes in the house like a round table, rectangle door etc.

### **Piglets**

The children have been showing a keen interest in the insects, birds and plants in the garden area. We will extend this interest by providing a variety of activities including ladybird crafts, plastic insects in jelly, planting and looking after seeds and flowers and a selection of nature books. These activities will encourage the children to notice detailed features of objects in their environment and to learn new words and be able to use them in communicating. Parent participation – When you are out for a walk with your child discuss the birds, flowers, and insects that you see with them

#### **Tiggers**

The children are showing a great interest in Space at the moment. We are extending this interest by offering a variety of space related activities for the children to explore such as galaxy playdough, moon sand, and shape and number rocket collages. These activities will encourage the children to begin to be interested in and describe the texture of things and to show an interest in shapes and numerals in the environment.

**Parent participation** – Talk about Space with your child, look at books, find out about planets on the internet etc. You could also make Rocket models out of empty boxes and bottles.

## **Christopher Robins**

The children in Christopher Robbins are all interested in being more independent when putting on their coats, shoes etc., which is great practice for when they start school. This interest will be extended by continuing to encourage the children to put on their own coats when going outside and changing their own clothes if needed, also by providing a

variety of dressing up clothes for them to use and dolls clothes and dolls to dress in the role-play area. These activities will encourage the children to increase their health and self-care skills and gain confidence in this area.

Parent participation – Give your child time to put on their own clothes and coats, they will get quicker with practice. We have shown the children the over the head method to put on their coats so ask them to show you how this works.
