Interests and Activities in Nursery

Roos, Piglets, Tiggers and Christopher Robins

The children are all exploring their new environments and investigating new toys and equipment in their rooms. As well as getting to know the staff within the rooms. As many of the children are experiencing new environments please be aware that this may disrupt some of their routines, for example, if they do not have a daytime nap they may return to having one every now and then, if they are toilet trained they may have a few accidents as they settle and they may become a little upset at drop off time. These are all natural behaviours and nothing to worry about. We will work with you and your children to ensure they settle as quickly as possible.

All the children in Christopher Robins will be painting their own canvas bags to use in nursery. The Christopher Robins team ask you please to use these bags, instead of backpacks, as they take up less room which means all the children can hang their own canvas bag on the pegs in the room, thank you.

Parent participation – Please speak to your child about nursery and the room that they are in, encourage them to tell you about the staff and new experiences that they are having.

COVID:19 Operating Procedures
